The Waters of Minocqua has a 40' x 80' fully enclosed tent (that includes state of the art sound equipment and quiet heat sources) where we will hold the large speaker meetings and Saturday night Banquet. It is a stationary tent firmly constructed on a concrete slab that has a tiled floor. The outdoor view of towering pines in the fall adds a Northwoods flavor as we follow a lovely walk-way from the hotel to the tent.

Because of Minocqua's noise ordinance that goes into effect at 10:00 p.m., we will hold the dance from 8:30 pm-Midnight in the Rendezvous Room in the hotel which can accommodate 150 people.

We have been promised 8 meeting rooms that will be used for Panels, Hospitality, Sell CD's, Archives/Area Displays/Literature, Alcahons: 10 pm till 6 am on Friday and Saturday.
